Richard Edward Green, of New Kent County went home to be with the Lord at the age of 73, on August 25, 2020, after a prolonged illness.

Richard was born in Worcester, Massachusetts on June 7, 1947 to Richard and Evelyn Green. He lived in Oxford, Massachusetts until he joined the army in 1967. He was a sergeant in the U.S. Army, 101st Airborne Division and served two tours of duty in the Vietnam War. Richard was wounded in action and decorated with two Purple Hearts.

He retired after 33 years of service at Saint-Gobain, formerly the Norton Company, in Worcester Massachusetts. Shortly thereafter, he married Janice and they moved to Providence Forge, Virginia. While in Virginia, Richard took on a job as a maintenance supervisor at a Presbyterian Church camp for 8 years. While skilled in all trades, his favorite hobby was in cabinetry and making furniture.

Richard served the Lord in many ways, from presenting the children's sermon in church, to participating in helping behind the scenes of vacation bible school creating stage props, and most recently by hand crafting a podium for the church, he and his wife attend. He and his wife Janice liked to travel and he especially enjoyed the natural beauty of Alaska.

Richard loved the Lord and helping others. He will always be remembered for his quick wit and wonderful sense of humor. He was preceded in death by his parents and only brother, Timothy.

He is survived by his wife, Janice; brother-in-law, Bruce Griggs and his wife Joanne; his nephew, Daniel Griggs and wife Rachel; his niece, Macy Riegerix and her husband Andrew, along with two great nephews and a great niece.
