Algie Bradford “Buddy” Ward, Jr. was called on August 13, 2018 by his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ to be with Him. Buddy graduated from VPI and was a Korean War veteran, serving with the 501st Airborne Infantry. He was the Assistant Country Agent of Nansemond County, VA, and worked at Smith Douglass, John Blue Equipment and Old Dominion Grain, before retiring from the Lebanon Chemical Corporation.

Buddy is survived by his wife Rae Via Nichols Ward; his children Algie B. Ward, III (Beth), Elizabeth Ann Jordan (Betty), Karen Borja (Dave), Laura Germain (Scott), and Randy Nichols (Denise); three sisters Margaret Gaskins, Mary Ward and Rosalie Hoblet; nine grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.
