



Alvah Hovey Eubank Jr.

March 9, 1926 - December 5, 2016

Alvah Hovey Eubank, Jr., of Mattaponi, VA formerly of West Point, VA died peacefully at his home surrounded by his family on December 5, 2016. He was a graduate of Virginia Tech and retired from Chesapeake Corporation as Treasurer after thirty years of service. Al was a World War II Army veteran and an active member of West Point Christian Church where he served as an elder and Board member to the congregation since 1961. After retirement he served on the Board at Rappahannock Community College and on the King and Queen County Wetlands Board for sixteen years.

Al was preceded in death by his wife of 57 years, Julia Carter Eubank and a twin brother, David Sutton Eubank.

He is survived by two sons, Carter Eubank (PJ) and Tommy Eubank (Anita); a daughter, Anne Eubank (Tim Fitzgerald); six grandchildren, Chris Dobbins (Amy), Aaron Eubank (Whitney), Katie Eubank, Emily Eubank, Kyle Bohannon and Dana Bohannon; two great-grandchildren Paige and Cora Dobbins and another on the way Max Eubank.
