



Alvin Pitts Farinholt

August 30, 1921 - January 11, 2015

Alvin Pitts Farinholt, 93, husband of the late Dorothy Sykes Farinholt for almost 60 years passed away at home Sunday, January 11, 2015. Pitts was born on August 30, 1921 to the late William Thomas Farinholt and Mary Alice Pitts Farinholt. He served in the US Army Air Corps during WWII, flying combat missions as Crew Chief on a C47 including D-Day through the end of the war in the European Theatre.

After the war, Pitts started Farinholt Home Maintenance, his own plumbing, heating and electrical business, which he ran for over 35 years. He was an active member of the Williamsburg Exchange Club, the American Legion Post 39, and Tabernacle United Methodist Church.
