Andrew Quentin Pitts, III, better known as "Top", passed away June 1, 2020. He worked for Wayjo, Inc. for almost 30 years, but was an avid hunter and enjoyed numerous sports, socializing and was quite the jokester. Top was devoted to his sons, and spent much of the time coaching and supporting his boys through baseball, football, wrestling and hunting. He was known for taking a phone call and saying "I'll call you back", only to leave you hanging for that phone call back. You'd eventually get called, but it might be much later in the day before he remembered to ring you back.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Andrew Q. Pitts, Jr. and Hazel M. Lucas. Top is survived by his sons, Austin and Hunter Pitts; sister, Crystal Pitts; nephew and niece, Akeem Pitts and Aiyana Jones.
