Ann Elizabeth (Jefferson) Jones, 86, of Charles City County, Virginia, entered eternal rest on Sunday, March 27, 2022. She was the youngest child born on April 22, 1935 to the late Jane Oliver (Brown) Jefferson and the late Peter Jefferson.

Ann finished Charles City Public Schools and then settled into life as a stay at home mom while raising her children. Family has always been most important to her.

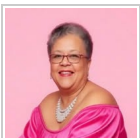
