Anna Hill Davis, 85, of New Kent, VA passed away March 31, 2018. She was born in Salem on November 1, 1932 to the late Fred and Gertrude Hill.

Anna graduated from Andrew High School and Roanoke Memorial School of Nursing. She received her nurse practitioner degree from Medical College of Virginia. Her nursing career spanned over 46 years and she exemplified the true meaning of a nurse.

She enjoyed painting, playing bridge, collecting recipes and cookbooks. She was a member of St. Peter's Episcopal Church where she was a senior warden, a member of the altar guild and founding member of R & D committee. Anna was the chairman of the 400 anniversary of the Godspeed Festival Committee.
