Arnold "Buddy" Burcham, 66, of Toano, VA passed away September 25, 2015. He was an Air Force veteran of the Vietnam War and stationed in Langley. Buddy retired from NASA after 25 years of service in 2006. He was preceded in death by his parents Arnold B. and Susie Hicks Burcham.
