Barbara Jenkins Barbour, of Williamsburg, Virginia, passed away on October 12, 2025, at the age of 91, while in hospice care following a fall.

Barabra was a devoted wife and mother who resided in West Point, Virginia, most of her adult life. She had a love of, and a talent for the arts and education. As a matter of fact, she met her future husband, Charles Barbour, when she was directing a play in which he played “the villain”. She sang in the community choir “The Enthusiastix” the church choir, and she taught Sunday school for a number of years. She created beautiful works of art in watercolor and scratch board.
