I have told this story thousands of times to people I have come across over the years as well as all my doctors and nurses. With this story, I pray that I was able to lead a lot of people to Christ. So now I hear my Father say to me: "Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things. I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness."

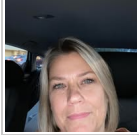
