Burnet Alan Beswick, 60, passed away July 26, 2014. After graduation from West Point High School in 1971, Alan earned a degree from Rappahannock Community College in business management and an associate's degree in applied science. He retired from Verizon telephone company and was a member of West Point United Methodist Church. Alan may have been most well-known for his work with the West Point High School football team, which he began in 1967 and continued through 2013, receiving the Virginia High School League Region A Award of Merit in 2008. He was preceded in death by his father, William R. Beswick. Alan is survived by his mother, Josephine Beswick; two sisters, Sandra Urban (Rod) of Bradenton, FL and Vicki Blake (Ernie) of Topping, VA; nieces and nephews, Christy Bruce, Meredith Kuebler, Matthew Urban and Michael Blake; great nieces and nephews, William, Hailey, Chase, Brayden, Brock and Charlotte; and several uncles, aunts and cousins. A graveside service will be held 11 a.m. Wednesday, July 30th at Sunny Slope Cemetery, West Point, VA.
