Calvin R. Sutherlin, 75, of New Kent, VA entered into eternal rest Tuesday, April 13, 2021 at Henrico Health and Rehab Center after a lengthy illness.

Calvin was born to Ozella and Warren Sutherlin on February 4, 1946 in New Kent, VA. He confessed Christ at an early age and was baptized. Calvin was educated in the New Kent County Public School System and joined the US Army where he served three plus years with an honorable discharge. He went on to be employed and eventually retired from the New Kent County Courthouse having worked as a Janitorial Supervisor. While Calvin never married or had any children, he loved his nieces and nephews. He was the type of person who enjoyed being around family, but only visited for a little while. Calvin always seemed to be deep in thought, but he never shared those thoughts.
