



Carl Kermit Miles Jr.

July 22, 1944 - May 6, 2025

Carl K. Miles, Jr., 80, departed this life on Tuesday, May 6, 2025. Born on July 22, 1944, he was the son of the late Carl K. Miles, Sr. and Effie Adkins Jefferson Miles.

In addition to his parents, Carl was preceded in death by his brother, William “Sonny” Jefferson, and sister, Peggy Holmes.

He leaves to cherish his memory his loving wife, Nancy B. Miles; his daughter, Lori M. “Hosey” Diaz (Alfredo); his son, Joe “Crow” Miles; five grandchildren, Juan Diaz (Nicole), Kelly Miles, Isis Barrett (Scott), Evelyn Abarca (Carlos), and Chino Diaz (Diana); and ten great-grandchildren, including one devoted great-grandson, Emery Diaz. 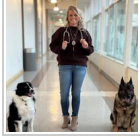
