Celia Adelle Post, “Adelle”, of Providence Forge, passed from this life into the arms of her Lord and Savior on October 30, 2014. She was born in Richmond, VA on Nov. 19, 1940. She moved to Providence Forge with her husband, Charles Edward Post, upon their marriage on Oct. 22, 1960. They were lovingly wed for 54 years.
