“ From my parents (Stuart and Beth Ferguson) who are overseas but had their own memory to share:

*I can picture the time we first met Charlie, very soon after we did the initial clearing on the property (in the early summer of 1981). Sonny Waltrip had finished drilling the well and then brought his equipment out our cleared, but not prepared or surfaced, "road" in the middle of a terrific thunderstorm. The result was a wet and muddy series of bottomless sinkholes that greeted our first delivery of milled lumber to the work site on Wesley Sheldon's brand new flatbed truck. Somehow we convinced the young driver that she could make the turn from the utility cut and come up the path through the woods to the house site. Big mistake as the truck was completely and hopelessly sunk at an angle in the Charles City clay. Of course, in those days before cell phones, she had no way to communicate with the yard. Our small Ford 8N tractor was incapable of pulling the truck, with it's heavy load, out of the mire--not that we didn't try! So, we walked down to Woody and Annie's house and asked if we could borrow the slightly larger and newer Ford Jubilee tractor that they were borrowing from Charlie. Woody was doubtful about letting us do that--although they generously allowed us to use their old pickup truck on the site (which they called "Rusty"). Woody or Annie did manage to get hold of Charlie and after a not too long interval he came down with the tractor himself, looked over the mess we had gotten into, and proceeded to first pull off the lumber from the truck (something we'd begun to do, but it was slow work for the two of us, as the load included the 2x12x12' ST sills and the 2x12x20-24' primary rafters, plus all of the 2x10; 2x8 and 2x6 dimensional lumber we needed for the laminated post & beam construction of the main house and purlin-based roof). That was a lot of heavy lumber... Of course, the only way to "pull" the remaining lumber was to drag it off sideways and...into the mud and water that was supposed to be the access road. As we saw how Charlie maneuvered the tractor, at times on just its rear drive wheels it dawned on us why Woody was hesitant about letting us use it--and we were very glad that he was able to let Charlie know we needed*

*his help and expertise. After the load was off, he was then able to help the driver extricate the truck and get it turned around for its journey back to the yard. It's a wonder that Mr Sheldon not only didn't add a (massive) "handling" (cleaning, really) charge onto our account--and even still kept doing business with us, even though we had much to learn about how to be owner-builders, which included a chapter on "how to prepare a house site in the woods of Charles City County" (step 1: put in the road first ;-).*

*All of that hopefully awaited day of the first lumber delivery is recorded in our house project photo album--painful, but good memories. But especially good in meeting Charlie and finding that he indeed "was loved by everyone and was a very giving person. He worked 6 to 7 days a week but always had time to help someone in need." That was us--on that day--and many more over the years.*

*We will miss him. Charles City will not be the same without him.*

Helping carry him through the woods to the waiting helicopter, putting our tractor back in the shed, finishing the day's work of splitting firewood that we had been doing. Didn't say anything, just looked around and did what he could. A solid man. A humble man. A quietly, great man.*
