



Charles "Chuck" Davis

Surrounded by his family, Charles "Chuck" Davis, 79, answered God's call and went home to meet his Lord on March 12, 2022. He lived in Mechanicsville for nearly 25 years and due to health reasons, recently moved to reside at the Dominion Village in Williamsburg.

He was raised in James City County where he graduated from James Blair in 1960. Upon receiving the call to preach, he moved his family to NC where he graduated from the Southeastern Theological Seminary and began a life of service to his Lord.
