A memorial service will be held on Saturday, September 11 at Reedswood

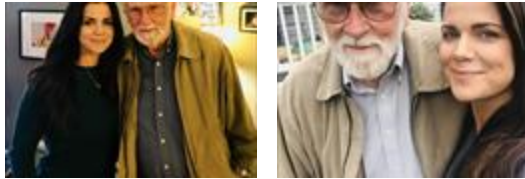
Christian Church (7694 Meredith Drive, Gloucester, VA) at 11am.
