Charles Edward Post, of Providence Forge, passed from this life into the arms of his Lord and Savior on October 14, 2021. Charles was affectionately known to many in Providence Forge and surrounding areas as “Buddy”, to his wife and family as “Chuck”, and he was known at work as “Stump”. He was also honored and elated to be called “Dad” by his sons, and “Papa” by his grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

He was born in Providence Forge, VA on January 26, 1938, and genuinely loved his hometown. Buddy was an original lifetime member with the Providence Forge Volunteer Rescue Squad, giving unselfishly of his time for many years to attend emergency calls and assist with community events, including their annual Halloween event for the children. He retired as a machine tender from Chesapeake Corporation in West Point, VA with over 30 years of service. Buddy greatly enjoyed working and staying busy, and he continued to work in the community for many years, both at Jean’s Diner as well as at Adams Sports Mart in Providence Forge.

Buddy expressed his faith as a member of Olivet Presbyterian Church in Providence Forge. His always-smiling countenance and shining character reflected to the world the definition of a truly good man. He was a friend to so many, never knew a stranger, and willingly and gladly gave all he could for those in need. He enjoyed watching hockey and baseball, and gardening,

fishing, and golfing. What Buddy loved the most though was spending time with his family and serving and giving to others.

He was preceded in death by his beloved wife of 54 years, Celia Adelle Post; his sister Mildred P. Smith, and his parents Walter and Lillian Post.

Remaining to cherish his memory are his sons, Todd E. Post of Providence Forge and Jeffrey E. Post Sr. of Charles City; his granddaughter Anna L. Post (Marquith) of Charles City, who unselfishly and lovingly acted as his caregiver prior to his death; his grandson Jeffrey E. Post Jr. (Kristin) of Charles City, his grandson Albert C. Post (Hayley) of King William, and 7 great-grandchildren: Justin, Jayden, Jordyn, Charlie, Bowen, Cora, and Kayla. Buddy is also survived by his former daughter-in-law, Lisa G. Post, who was of great comfort and aid to him prior to his passing, as she also acted as one of his caregivers.
