Charlotte Lorraine Wright Tribble of Richmond died on Saturday, October 26, 2019. The daughter of Lorraine Ruffin and George Wright, Jr., she was predeceased by her parents, her brother, Julian Meade Wright and her husband, George Meredith Tribble III. After her family began, she resided in West Point, VA for thirty years as a dedicated wife, mother and volunteer in the community. She returned to Richmond where she lived at Westminster Canterbury in her later years and rejoined St. James's Episcopal Church.
