



## Christie Taylor

December 25, 1916 - December 18, 2010

Taylor, Christie Carol (Evans), 93, passed on December 18th at the Gloucester House in Gloucester, VA. She was born Christie Carol Evans in Union Level, VA on Christmas day in 1916 to John Wesley and Willie Alma (Taylor) Evans. She always loved to tell the story of her mother not wanting to name her Christmas Carol so settled on Christie Carol instead. She was predeceased by her parents, an infant brother, and her husband of 43 years, Robert Henry Taylor.
