Dean L. Greer, 85, of West Point, VA, passed away suddenly September 21, 2019.

He was the owner and president of West Point Log Corporation. He was a Nashville recording artist and owner of Deville records. He was a CMA Sterling member and performed around the East Coast in various venues. Dean was preceded in death by his wife of 63 years, Christine Greer; two brothers, Sherill and Joe Greer; one sister, Christina Endicott. He is survived by his son, Wayne L. 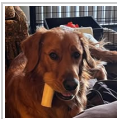
