It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Diane Breeden Rilee, our beloved Mom/Nan/Lil' Nan, on May 13, 2026. She was surrounded by family as she peacefully departed this world.

Diane was born in Charlottesville, Virginia, on May 5, 1942. She was married for 65 years to her high school sweetheart, Robert Jeffries (Jeff) Rilee, who preceded her in death. She was a loving mom to daughter, Elizabeth (Beth) Rilee Kelley (Paul) and son, Robert Jeffries (Jeffrey) Rilee, Jr., and grandmother to four beautiful grandchildren who were some of her biggest fans: Breeden Kelley Browning (Matt), Paul Thomasson Kelley, Jr. (Samantha), Harlow Rilee Foster (Tyler), and Travis Lucas Haurand (Jennifer). She was proud of her eight remarkable great-grandchildren and enjoyed hearing about their accomplishments and antics.
