Donald Clark “Donnie” Wyatt 69, of Richmond, died peacefully in his home October 14, 2019. 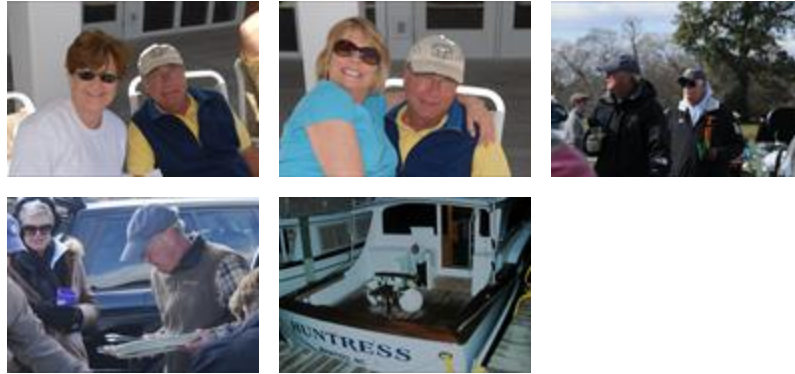
