He was a passionate sports fan of the Baltimore Orioles and Ravens, who spent many years coaching, first as a founder of Wilson Point Football, and later in many baseball and football coaching roles for Middle River and Perry Hall Recreation centers.

Buzz was preceded in death by his father and mother, Elmer F. Peddicord and Edna Louise Morgan. He is survived by his wife, Barbara Anne Peddicord; four children, Chris, Craig, Keith and Kim; his sister, and her husband, Gwendolyn and Larry Krug; eight grandchildren; one great-grandson; and a host of countless nephews, nieces and cousins.

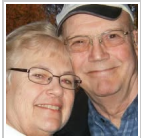
