



Florence Dandridge Morris

September 12, 1928 - December 9, 2017

Nannie Florence Morris was born September 12, 1928 to the late Stephen and Mary Dandridge. She was called home to eternal rest on Saturday morning, December 9, 2017, at Riverside Tappahannock Hospital.

Florence, affectionately known as “Pine”, accepted Christ at an early age and became a member of Trinity Baptist Church in Center Cross. She served her church faithfully and was the “Mother of Trinity”. Her primary education was completed at the Center Cross School and her secondary education at the Rappahannock Industrial Academy (RIA) in Dunnsville, Virginia where she graduated in 1946.

On May 29, 1948, Florence and Winfield Edward Morris, Sr. were united in Holy Matrimony and together they parented five children: Earl, Winfield, Jr., Cynthia (Sister), Stacey and Denise.

She was preceded in death by her husband Winfield Morris, son Winfield Morris, Jr.; three brothers Stephen, Clayton, Sr., and William (Bill); and five sisters Margaret, Annie Louise, Virginia, Rose, and Dorothy.
