



Mr. Gian Minh Duong

December 23, 1924 - February 22, 2013

Gian Minh Duong, 89 , of West Point, VA died Friday, February 22, 2013. He was born in Ha Dong, Ha Thao Vietnam. At the end of the Vietnam War, Gian single-handedly saved his entire family of 13 and many others by immigrating to the United States.

Gian retired from Virginia Eastern State Hospital after 12 years of service as a nurse's aide.

He was an active member of Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church.

Gian was preceded in death by his first wife An Bui.

He is survived by his wife Khieu Thi Dinh; three daughters Duong Thi Hoa, Duong Thi Phuong and Duong Thi Minh Huong; four sons Duong Tien Quy, Duong Vuong Hung, Duong Tien Duong and Duong La Vang; two brothers Duong Van Han, Duong Van Hung (Vietnam); 31 grandchildren and 4 great-grandchildren.

A funeral mass will be held 8 a.m. Monday, February 25th at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church, 3570 King William Avenue, West Point, VA 23181. Burial will follow in St. Theresa Cemetery. The family will receive friends Sunday 6 to 8 p.m. at Vincent Funeral Home, 417 11th Street, West Point, VA 23181.
