February 28, 1974 - August 2, 2020

Sergeant First Class Glen Loving, beloved son and loving father, was called home to the Lord on August 2, 2020, where he was reunited with his son Andrew and daughter Anna.

Aside from his family, Glen's greatest devotion was to the military. After joining the Virginia Army National Guard, he served in the US Army where he received numerous medals, campaign ribbons, and awards before retiring after 21 years of honorable service.

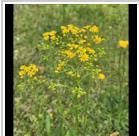

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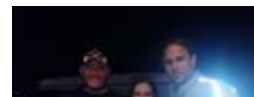
