SHACKLEFORDS, VA - Harold (Hal) Langerud, 83, of Shackelfords, VA died Saturday, October 8, 2016 at his residence surrounded by his loving family. He is survived by his children Steve and his wife Juliann Langerud, Cheryl and her husband James Bernoski, Brenda and her husband Harry Johnston, Bryan and his wife Lisa Langerud and Denise and her husband Jim Perry. He is also survived by ten grandchildren Jeromie, Jocelyn, Christina, Jamison, Ashley, Chance, Shane, Jakeb, Spence and Terry and seven great-grandchildren Camryn, Cody, Elly Cate, Smith, Cooper, Stone and Madison. Hal was born in the Providence of Saskatchewan, Canada, the son of the late John and Vera (Rusu) Langerud who returned with their family in 1940 to the United States to establish their home. He graduated from Peninsula High School in Gig Harbor, Washington in 1950, enlisting in the United States Air Force shortly thereafter. He retired after twenty years of honorable service attaining the rank of Master Sergeant. Upon his retirement Hal served as the President of the Oregon chapter of the Air Force Association receiving the Associations Medal of Merit for his outstanding leadership. Transitioning to civilian life Mr. Langerud served as a Technical Division Manager at Western Technical Services in Beaverton, Oregon. In 1988 he was selected as a Norberg Award Winner for outstanding technical and customer service. In 2003 he returned to the Virginia area to be closer to his family. Possessing a keen intellect, "Papa Hal" thoroughly enjoyed reading and resolving mechanical problems by utilizing his wood-working and engineering skills. He

loved riding his golf cart around Tucker's Recreational Park and joining his many friends there for evening cocktails. A celebration of "Papa Hal's" life will be held at the Tucker's Recreational Park Pavilion at 4 p.m. on Thursday, October 13th, 2016, immediately followed by a celebration because after all "It's five o'clock somewhere." 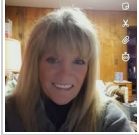
