A celebration of life will be held at Lifepointe Christian Church in Toano, VA at 6:00 PM Wednesday July 30, 2025.

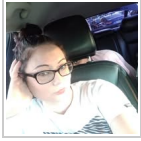

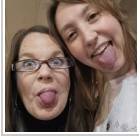

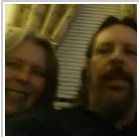
