James Edward Medlock of James City County, VA departed this life on Friday, May 2, 2025, after a brief period of waning health. He maintained a road produce stand, and customers were eager to enjoy the fruits of his labor. James is also remembered fondly for hosting many family reunions at his home in James City County. James will be missed by family and friends.
