Jason Douglas Harlow, 47, passed away suddenly March 12, 2019. For the past 20 years, he has been a devoted police officer with the West Point Police Department. Jason greatly enjoyed hunting, fishing and caring for his many animals. He was best known for his friendly demeanor, his big personality and his love for people. Time spent hanging out with loved ones and friends, often cooking delicious meals for them, was one of his favorite things to do; and he always made it a good time.

Jason is survived by the love of his life and his wife of 24 years, Susan; his son, Brendan; parents, Linda and Thomas Harlow; and his brother, Kenneth Harlow; many extended family members and countless friends.
