Loved by generations, she will always be remembered for her beautiful smile, her positive and upbeat attitude, and

her dedication to any task. She found something to appreciate and admire in everyone she met, and was deeply loved by multiple generations. Often described by her daughters as the light of their lives, Mrs. Thomas's light will continue to shine in all who were blessed to know and love her.

The family will receive friends in Richardson Hall at St. Peter's Episcopal Church, 8400 St. Peter's Lane, New Kent on Friday, June 9th from 5 to 7 PM, and a funeral service will be held in the church on Saturday, June 10th at 11 AM, with burial in the churchyard.
