Joe Netick, Jr. of Charles City, Virginia passed away on Friday, May 8, 2015. He was born in Del Rio, Texas on May 27, 1930. Predeceased by his parents, Joe and Sarah Hardin Netick and also by his brother, Allan, he is survived by his wife, Anne Tyler Netick, and two daughters, Celia Pennington of Corinth, Texas (Bill), and Linda Petty, of Prescott, Arizona.

Always an excellent student, Joe attended schools in Del Rio and Culver Military Academy before entering Tulane University in New Orleans. He earned both his undergraduate degree and his M.D. degree at Tulane and began his medical career in Wharton, Texas where he established a successful dermatology office.

Joe and Anne Tyler met in Aspen, Colorado where Anne was attempting to learn how to ski. That meeting, in time, led to marriage, and Joe moved to Charles City, where, continuing his calling as a dermatologist, he took an additional role of “preservationist” as he and Anne sought to restore “Woodbourne” an early home built by Anne’s great grandfather, John Tyler. Joe was also an Air Force veteran, retiring as Lt. Colonel in 1997. He enjoyed his time in the Air Force, especially his tour of duty in Japan where he had an opportunity to learn a new language; he liked studying languages, the more exotic the better.

In retirement, Joe enjoyed country life with his garden and animals, especially “Ziggy” his feline companion. Joe was known for his hospitality and generosity, and for his big, friendly, Texas smile. He will be greatly missed and never

forgotten by those who knew him and loved him.

A memorial service will be held at Westover Church in Charles City, the date to be determined.
