John Yarrington Burton, 89, passed away quietly and peacefully on March 5, 2017. John was preceded in death by the love of his life Ethel Gaines Burton. John and Ethel were married for 63 years. He was also preceded in death by his sisters Ann Burton, Winnie Lee Tate, Eva Courtney Ross; brother in law Zane Grey Ross; nephew Timothy Glenn Gaines Tanner. John will be remembered by his nephews Blake Ross and his wife Joanne, David Ross and his wife Wanda; sister in law Joan Tanner; niece Tracy Bond, great niece Sarah Herbert; nephews, Thomas M. Tanner, Todd T. Tanner; great nephews Brian Ross, Stuart Ross, Michael Ross; many dear friends. John was born August 20, 1927 in Elsom, VA, the son of John Yarrington Burton and Annie Hobday. He graduated from Pleasant Hill High school in 1944, served in the United States Army, worked at Citizens & Farmers Bank in West Point and was the President of the Chesapeake Employees Federal Credit Union in West Point. John was a long time resident of West Point where he was active in his community. He was a member of West Point First Baptist Church, the Ruritan Club and served on many other boards and civic organizations. John donated over 100 units to the Mid Atlantic Bloodmobile. Most notably, John was the West Point Weatherman for 35 years. He was always interested in the weather and continued to follow weather patterns until the time of his recent illness. At the time of his death, John was a resident of Heron Cove in Gloucester, Va where he received loving care and support by the staff there. John will be remembered for his keen sense of humor, as a lifelong fan of the

Washington Redskins and the New York Yankees and for his care of friends and neighbors throughout his life.

A funeral service will be held 2 p.m., Thursday, March 9th at Vincent Funeral Home, 417 11th St., West Point, and interment will follow in Olivet Baptist Church Cemetery, King and Queen, Virginia. The family will receive friends from 1 to 2 p.m., just prior to the funeral service.


