Joseph Wendell Carlton (Cootie), 61, of King & Queen Court House, VA died Saturday, November 30th, 2013. He was preceded in death by his parents, Edward Lee and Josephine Elliott Carlton; one brother, Alvie H. Carlton; one sister, Verna May Carlton King; and a grandchild, Baby Bristow.

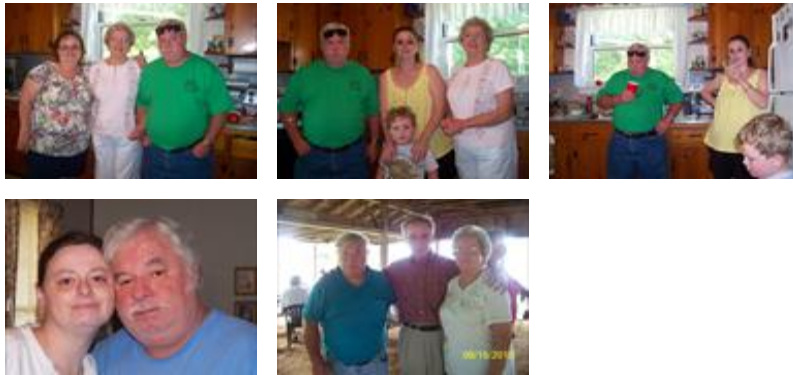
