



## Kathleen Fisher Schultz

May 23, 1936 - March 10, 2025

Schultz, Kathleen (Fisher) age 88 of Quinton passed away peacefully on March 10, 2025. She was preceded in death by her husband of 52 years, Norwood Schultz, her parents Wilbur and Stenza Fisher, and her brother Kenneth Fisher. She enjoyed homecoming at church each year. She especially enjoyed getting to see the folks that would come back to visit and enjoy all the wonderful food that Providence had to offer. Kathleen was well known across the county for her cooking, but most of all her poundcake and key lime pie. In fact, one of her black walnut poundcakes was auctioned off for \$400 at one of the church bake sales. She had a love for birds, and she would keep her feeders stocked by making sure they never ran out of food. She also enjoyed sitting in her kitchen and watching the hummingbirds at her kitchen window. She was the last surviving member of the Fab 5. This group
