January 21, 1976 - September 11, 2019

On Wednesday, September 11, 2019, God called home for eternal rest, our beloved, Kelvin Lamarr Christian, Jr. He passed away suddenly while vacationing in Bermuda.

He was born in Richmond, Va, on January 21, 1976, the son of Kelvin and Priscilla Christian.

At an early age, he confessed Christ and joined Ebenezer Baptist Church in Lanexa, Va, where he remained a faithful member until his death. Kelvin was employed by Johnson Controls as a site foreman for 15 faithful years. He was a dedicated member of Plumbers and Steamfitters local 10 union.

Mane was a die-hard Dallas Cowboys fan. When he wasn't fixing something or working on someone's AC unit, he loved to go fishing, hunting, spending time with his family and friends or profiling in his Chevelle. He had a genuine passion and love for coaching little league football. He was a role model and a mentor to the youth of New Kent and Richmond Communities.
