



Mr. Kent Brockett VanDervort

March 10, 1927 - December 2, 2012

Kent Brockett VanDervort, 85, of New Kent, VA died Sunday, December 2, 2012.

He was a Navy veteran of World War II. Kent served as a missionary in Haiti and treasurer of OMS International. He was an interim Commissioner of Revenue in New Kent County in 1995.

Kent is survived by his wife of 66 years, Norma Jean VanDervort; four children, Daniel VanDervort (Joan), Mark VanDervort (Dott), Mike VanDervort (Dawn), and Deborah Pope (Charles); two sisters, Lela Hall and Joan Black; nine grandchildren; and nine great-grandchildren.
