Lawrence S. Hill, 86, of Mount Hope Farm, King William, VA passed away February 17th, 2021. He was preceded in death by his parents, Robbie and Helen Hill; a sister, Nora Hill Temple; and a nephew, Robert Jordan Temple.

He retired from VDOT after 35 years and enjoyed farming part-time.
