Leroy C. Steffenhagen, 97, of Richmond, VA, formerly of Oklahoma City and Chicago, Illinois died Friday, September 11, 2015. He was born to the late John and Emma Steffenhagen on September 26, 1917 in Chicago, Illinois. Lee attended the University of Richmond and The University of Illinois. He was a World War II army sergeant stationed in Presidio, San Francisco. Lee married Evelyn Beseman on June 28, 1941 and they lived 72 years together in Dolton, Illinois, Cedar Rapids, Iowa, Nebraska and Oklahoma City. In November of 2012, they relocated to Richmond, VA to be close to family. Lee was an active member of Messiah Lutheran Church in Oklahoma City for 42 years and an avid sports fan. He was preceded in death by his wife, Evelyn who died February 3, 2014.
