Lindsey Maxwell Worthington, 31, passed away in early March of 2017. Lindsey was born in Washington, DC, and was raised there as well as in Cheverly, Maryland and Richmond, Virginia. She graduated from John Randolph Tucker High School in 2003 where she studied in the French Immersion Program and attended J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College in Richmond, Virginia. She studied for her Bachelor of Science in Nursing at South University.

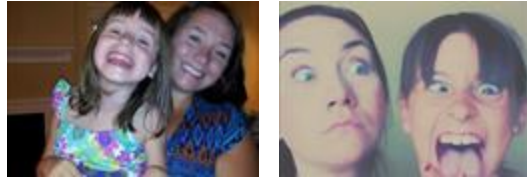
