DEACON MOSES ALVIN ROBINSON, 86, entered into eternal rest on Wednesday, October 21, 2020 at Riverside Tappahannock Hospital. He was born on February 17, 1934 to the late James and Idabelle Robinson of Stevensville, VA.

Deacon Robinson was educated in the Edgehill Public School system. He joined the Wayland Baptist Church at an early age and served as a Deacon for many years. Deacon Robinson was a dedicated member of Wayland; however he enjoyed fellowshiping at Gethsemane and Zion Baptist church and other churches in the community.

Deacon Robinson was joined in holy matrimony to Ruth Thompson on October 22, 1960. They would have celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary the day following his transition into eternal rest.
