We had 26 players trying out that year, and there were some older, bigger, and stronger players interested in catching. As try-outs continued, and even into some of the first games, we still hadn't committed to a catcher, but as time passed, Nik's determination and dedication to the team became more and more apparent. He must have been working out on his own time outside of practice, because his throws to second base became stronger and quicker over a very short time. My son, Ross, always loved to have Nik as his catcher. He said he never hesitated to throw a curve in the dirt with a runner on third with Nik catching. He knew Nik would stop the ball at any cost.

Nik always gave 110%, not only at games, but also at every practice. He was never lazy and did everything the coaches asked of him. He was always very respectful and any coach would have been proud to have him on the team. I know I was.

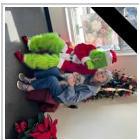
