He served in the Korean War from 1950-1952 with the 25th Infantry Division 65th Combat Engineer Battalion. He was president of the 467 International Pulp Workers Union, Commander of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, coached little league baseball, boy scout leader, and participated in many other organizations.
