With heavy hearts, we announce the passing of Randy Martin Sprigg, 55, of New Kent, VA on June 9th, 2025. He and his wife, Cara, shared 29 years of marriage together.

Randy was born in Williamsburg, VA; he was the son of Robert and Vicki Sprigg. He graduated from Lafayette High School, then continued his education at Old Dominion University, where he received a Bachelor's Degree in Mechanical Engineering in 1994.
