Richard "Dick" Rundle, 81, passed away at home May 26, 2015, surrounded by his family. He was a resident of New Kent, VA, for 2 years, but called Bedford County, VA, home for over thirty years. In 1981, he moved to Bedford County and started his journey with a new set of lifelong friends. He never met a stranger and easily made friends with everyone. He retired from Metropolitan Life in 1989 and began driving handicapped children to school in Bedford County. He retired from the Bedford County School System in 2006. 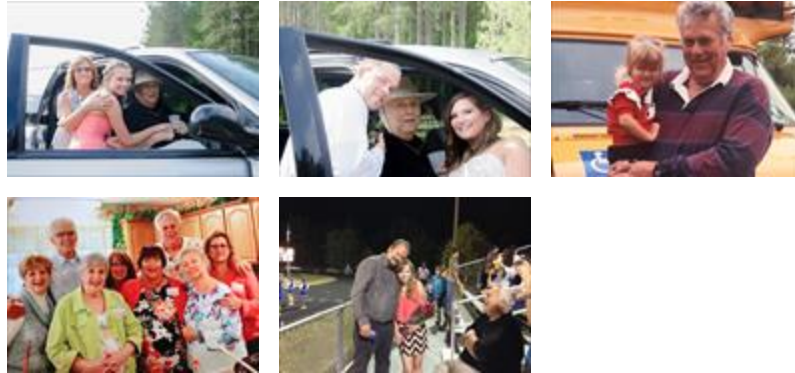
