Robert Joseph Naggy "Bob", 90 years old. Born 1-1-34 on the family farm in King and Queen County, Virginia and passed peacefully with family at his bedside on November 1st, 2024 at Sentara Virginia Beach General Hospital.

A longtime resident of Virginia Beach, Bob spent his early life on the farm. Upon moving to West Point, VA, he attended Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Catholic School and graduated from West Point High School. Bob served in the Army during the Korean War. He was a graduate of Old Dominion University, known as William and Mary satellite campus at the time.

Bob was preceded in death by his parents Joseph and Florence Naggy as well as his sister Mildred Hite, all of West Point, VA. He was widowed twice. Married to his first wife, Margaret "Peggy" Naggy for 44 years before her death in 2001. His second wife, Marilyn Jacobson passed in 2021 after 15 years of marriage. Bob was devoted to his Catholic faith. He served as an altar boy in West Point and was a past Grand Knight of Knights of Columbus Council 9056 at St Gregory's. He also attended Holy Family Catholic Church.
