“BeBe was profoundly important in my life, especially when I was young. As a teenager, I often found my way to Bob and BeBe’s home when I needed a safe, happy place to land. What they gave me—without fanfare or conditions—was warmth, stability, and a sense of belonging, and BeBe was at the heart of that.

BeBe had a wonderful, unmistakable presence. She was funny in a way that was entirely her own, often telling jokes she somehow managed to derail in the telling, which only made them funnier. She brought levity, warmth, and an ease that made people feel welcome the moment they walked in the door.

Music—especially improvisational jazz—was a big part of the connection Bob and I shared (we both played drums), and BeBe was always right there. She would listen, smile, and say it sounded like the musicians were “just practicing,” a comment that became part of the joy and laughter of those moments.

Beyond the humor and the music, what I will always remember most is the home BeBe helped create—a place of generosity, kindness, and quiet care. Along with Bob, she gave me refuge during a time in my life when I needed it more than I knew how to say.

BeBe’s family—her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren—were clearly the center of her world. Both Bob and BeBe had a sparkle in their eye that became a shared light, speaking to their love of family, laughter, and the simple pleasures of being together.

BeBe was deeply and widely loved, and for good reason. I will always be grateful for her kindness, her humor, and the place she holds in my life and in my heart. I’m holding her family very close and sending love and gratitude for an extraordinary woman.

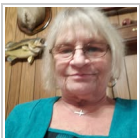
