



## Rosemary Seidnitzer Slayton

January 5, 1947 - May 20, 2019

Rosemary Seidnitzer Slayton, 72, wife of Edward (Gunner) Slayton, died May 20, 2019 after a long battle with cancer. Rosemary was born and grew up in Hampton before moving to Lanexa in 1974.
