Deaconess Rosetta Cauthorne Amy, 82, of Laneview VA entered into eternal rest on Monday April 13, 2020. She was the daughter of the late Thomas Cauthorne, Sr. and the late Mary Lizzie Morris Cauthorne. Deaconess Amy attended school in Essex County. She graduated from Essex High School in 1956.

Deaconess Amy joined Union Shiloh Baptist Church at an early age. She served in the following capacities: Choir Member, Missionary Member and Deaconess Ministry. She served as the Chairman for the Missionary Annual and Women's Day Programs for many years. She also served as the Treasurer for the Missionary Circle for many years.
